

Important Cleaning Advice

To protect your panels, never use abrasive products or harsh chemicals or solvents, as they can cause permanent damage or discoloration. Avoid the following:

- ✗ Acidic cleaners e.g. vinegar, rust removers, or limescale removers
- ✗ Alkaline cleaners e.g. bleach, oven cleaners, baking soda.
- ✗ Ammonia-based cleaners e.g. window and glass cleaners
- ✗ Strong solvents e.g. acetone, isopropyl alcohol (IPA) or methylated spirits
- ✗ Abrasive cleaners e.g. scouring pads, rough sponges, or gritty cleaners like CIF
- ✗ ABS edgetape cleaner.

Easy Cleaning Steps:

1. Wipe up spills and stains immediately using a soft, non-abrasive cloth.
2. Clean everyday smudges and marks with warm water and a microfiber cloth.
3. For heavier dirt, add a few drops of mild dishwashing liquid to warm water and gently wipe.
4. Use new cleaning products with caution—test on an inconspicuous area first.
5. For stubborn stains, lightly dampen a microfiber cloth with mineral turpentine and gently wipe.
6. Repeat as needed until clean.
7. Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, non-abrasive cloth to avoid streaks or residue.
